Separate sealed bids for **Lake Fort Smith and Grotto Valve Upgrades, Project No. 17-16-Cl**, will be received by the City of Fort Smith, Arkansas, at the **Office of the Director of Utilities** until **11:00 a.m. (Local Time), Tuesday, February 2nd, 2021**, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. Bids shall be addressed "**City of Fort Smith, Utility Department, 801 Carnall Avenue, Suite 500, Fort Smith, Arkansas 72901**" and shall be labeled **Bid for Lake Fort Smith and Grotto Valve Upgrades, Project No. 17-16-Cl**. Bidders are to include their Arkansas License number on the outside of their sealed bid. **Bids shall only be received from registered Bidders.**

The project consists of two schedules. Schedule One includes removal of a 20" cone valve & installation of a new 30" ball valve & appurtenances including a new vault & 30 LF of 30" steel pipe. Schedule Two includes placing a 48" butterfly valve in an existing vault at the LFS Water Treatment Plant.

The owner reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids.


Each bidder must deposit with his bid, security in the amount, form and subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders.
